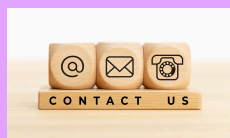

BOTH CRAWFORD COUNTY LIBRARY BRANCHES OFFER A VARIETY OF ITEMS FOR CHECKOUT INCLUDING: NONFICTION, FICTION, CHILDREN'S, YOUNG ADULT, GRAPHIC NOVELS, AUDIO BOOKS, HOTSPOTS, MOVIES AND TV SERIES, NOOKS, AND BOARD GAMES. WE ALSO HAVE A MICHIGAN SECTION AND FLY FISHING SECTION. MOST ITEMS CHECK OUT FOR 4 WEEKS, WITH THE EXCEPTION OF NEW RELEASES AND HOTSPOTS FOR 2 WEEKS, AND DVDS FOR 1 WEEK. TV SERIES CHECKOUT FOR 2 WEEKS. THERE IS A CHECKOUT LIMIT OF 2 NEW RELEASE BOOKS, 5 DVDS, AND AN OVERALL LIMIT OF 10 ITEMS AT ANY ONE TIME.

*Crawford County Library is fine free. With the exception of board games and hotspots. Patrons may be charged late fees when borrowing interlibrary/MeL items. CCL will still charge for lost/damaged items and collection fees.

*Please note that a \$12 collection fee (non-refundable) and a \$5 processing fee (non-refundable) will be charged to patron accounts. Additionally, a \$5 fee will be applied to patron accounts for any damaged items.
